Patterned paper, seam binding, glitter foam, Moonshine sequins, Stickles glitter

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

Die cut a large oval from white cardstock using the Nesting Basics: Ovals die. Using a blending brush or other blending tool, sponge Spring Rain and Hawaiian Shores ink over the upper third of your oval. Add Summer Sunrise, Melon Sorbet, and Berry Sorbet in a circular motion just to the left of center, where your "O" in love will sit. Spritz with water droplets and let dry. Stamp secondary sentiment across bottom of card using Spring Rain ink, just below where "Love" will sit.

STEP 2:

Stamp small hearts using Hawaiian Shores ink over blue sponged ink on oval. I used hearts from the Love is Everywhere stamp set. Wrap seam binding around oval and tie in a bow on the right. Cut Larger Than Life Love once from white glitter foam and a second time from pink patterned paper. Layer patterned paper die cut over foam die cut, and adhere to center of oval.

STEP 3:

Die cut pots and flowers, stamp, and adhere to Larger Than Life: Love, as shown. Using tiny flowers and leaves from the All You Need is Love and Love is Everywhere stamp sets, stamp images following bottom curve of oval.

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 4:

Adhere completed oval to card front. Die cut Border Bling: Skinny Embossed Frame from Sweet Blush cardstock and adhere around border of card. Adhere a third pot with flowers in the lower left corner of card. Finish card by adding Moonshine sequins and Stickles glitter.
